- **5:15 PM** we head to El Palacio Mexican Restaurant at 401 E. Andy Devine Ave where we will enjoy dinner in their private banquet room. I hear their beer is so cold you may want to wear a coat while enjoying your brew.

- **Wednesday's Schedule:** Enjoy a leisurely breakfast courtesy of the Best Western, check out (or extend your stay) before we go to the museum.
- **9:15 AM** we head to the Power House Visitor Center & Route 66 Museum at 120 W. Andy Devine Ave. Entry fee is \$4.00 or \$3.00 senior and is good for 3 historic facilities in Kingman.

- Lunch and departure is on your own, at your leisure. You can drive Route 66 on to the Toprock/Golden Shores that ends the Historic Route or take in one of the other interesting venues in town.
